BVA Middle School Flexible Instructional Day (FID) Parent Information

The Pennsylvania Department of Education approved BVASD with the ability to implement five (5) Flexible Instructional Days (FID) per academic year in cases when circumstances prevent the delivery of instruction in its customary manner in location for any of the following reasons: an epidemic, a hazardous weather condition, a law enforcement emergency, the inoperability of school buses or other equipment a necessary to the public school entity’s operation, damage to a school building, or a temporary circumstance rendering any portion of a school building unfit or unsafe for use.

In the event that BVASD declares a FID, the following outlines the expectations for staff, families, and students:

- Families will be sent notification of a FID via phone, social media and www.bvasd.net.
- Students are expected to learn synchronously from home using their Chromebook & Google Classroom.
- Students must login to live, synchronous Zoom sessions with the links posted under Classwork within the student’s respective Google Classrooms.
- Staff will take and post Attendance each period, and students who do not login to their 1st period class by 8:18am will be marked absent.
- Students will follow the appropriate bell schedule listed below as declared the day of the FID.
